However, the Tricycle is a lot more than just a theatre. Set at the heart of the most diverse Borough in London, it also boasts a beautiful 300-seat cinema, a contemporary art gallery and great café and bar. Often unsung is its remarkable Education and Social Inclusion programme. Each year, there are over 40,000 attendances by young people to see plays and films, and to take part in visual and performing arts workshops. There is also an extensive programme working with disadvantaged young people in our community.

This artistic and educational work is very costly and, like many arts organisations, the Tricycle constantly struggles to make ends meet. Statutory and earned income cover approximately 85% of costs leaving a fundraising target in excess of £450,000 a year.

All of the proceeds from the Three Wheelin' Cabaret will go towards supporting the theatre's critically acclaimed productions and its broad education programmes.
